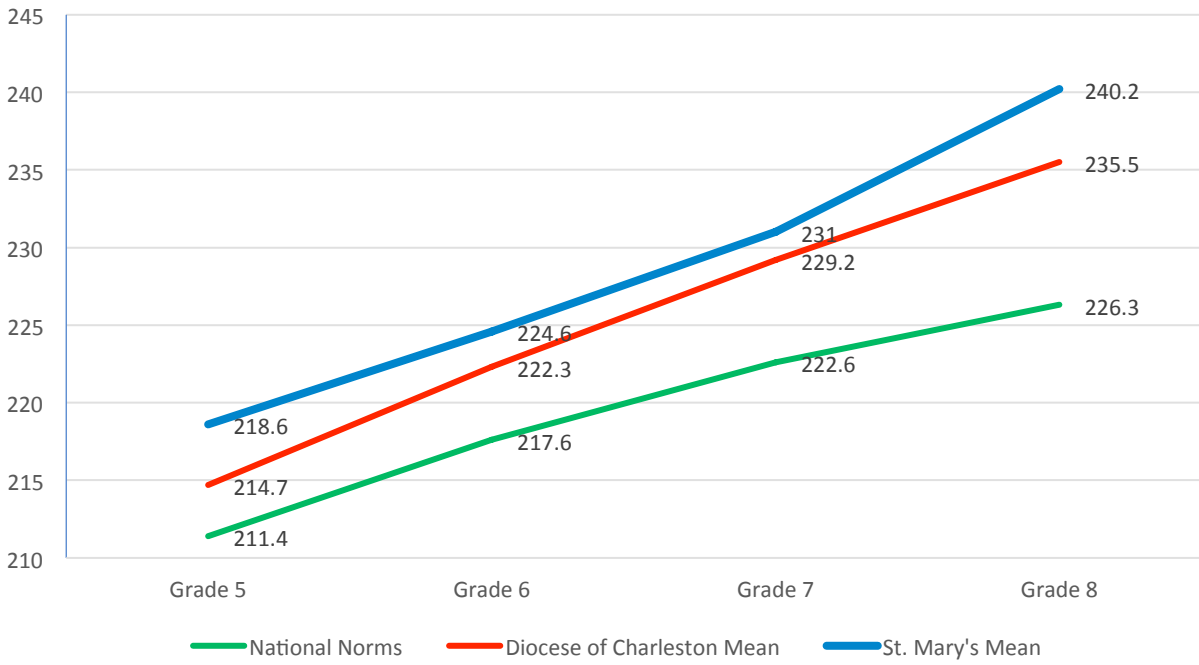

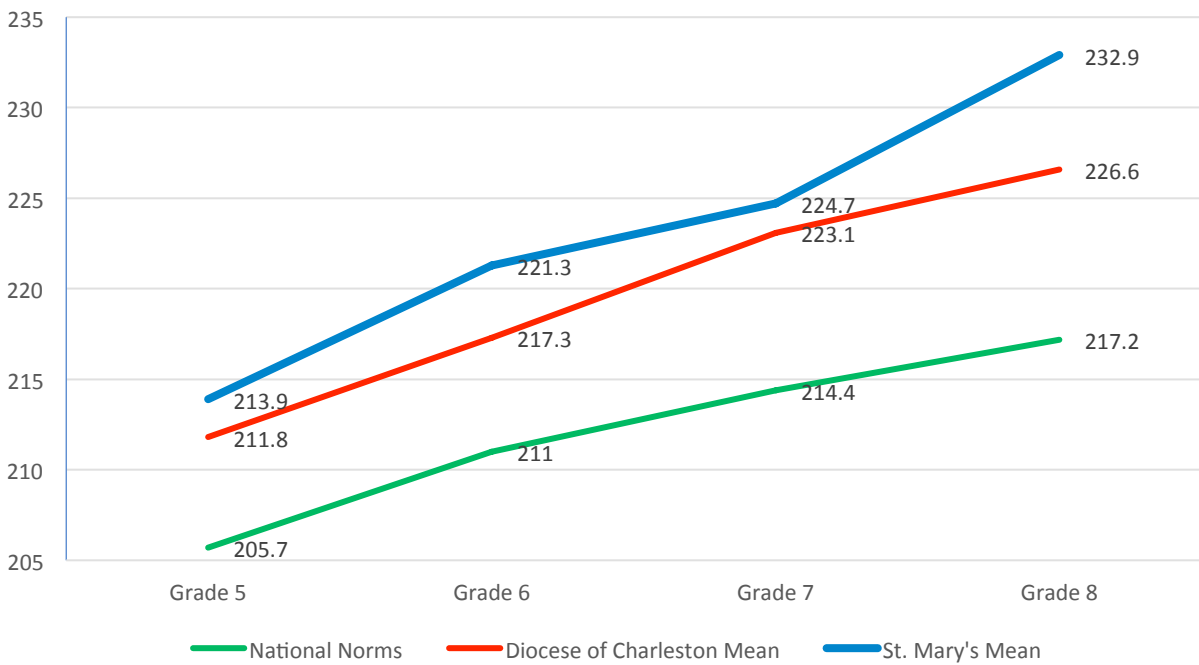

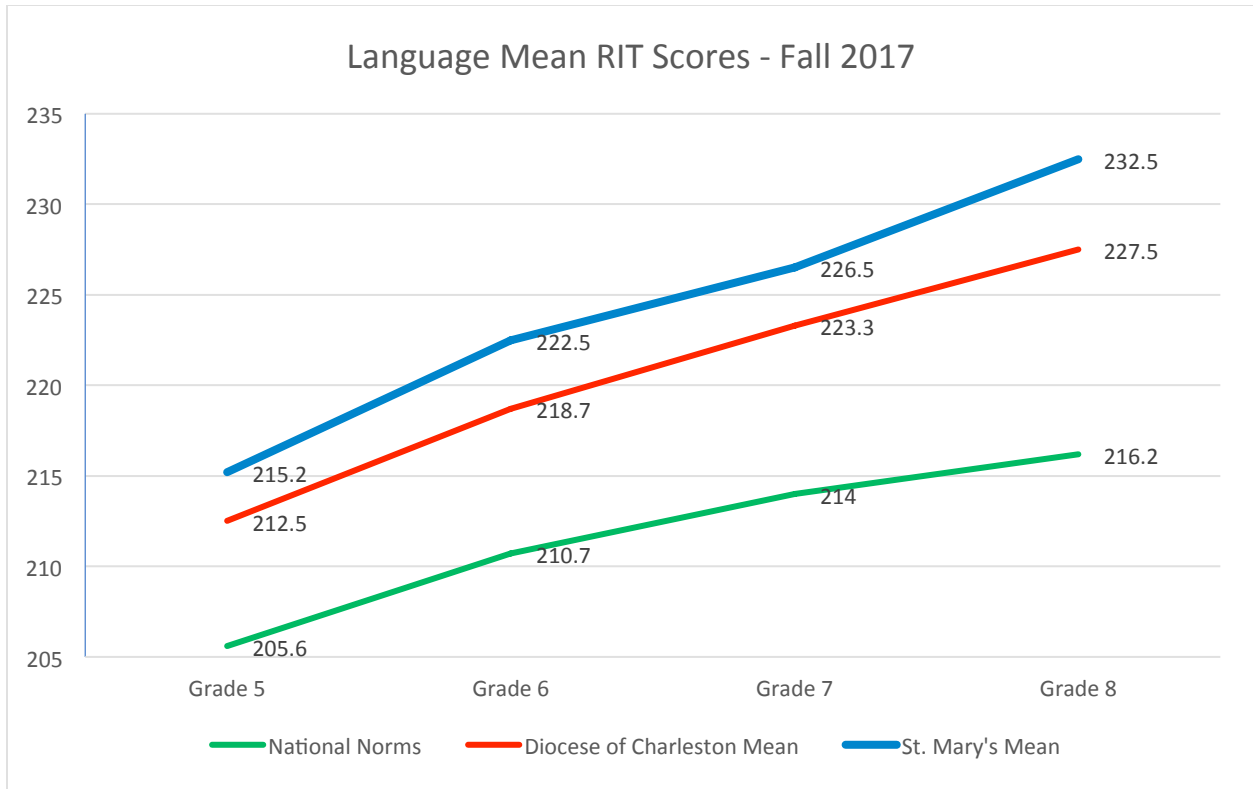

**Bottom Line:** **St. Mary's** students averaged higher than the **national average** (public plus private schools) and higher than the average for other Catholic school students in the **Diocese of Charleston** in **EVERY** subject and **EVERY** grade level throughout middle school, with the greatest achievement gap occurring in 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

*(NOT PICTURED: St. Mary's students also scored higher in every subject and at every grade level than the national Catholic schools average and the southeastern Catholic schools average.)*

The average student that attends St. Mary's middle school graduates better prepared for high school than the average student at either South Carolina public schools or other Catholic schools in the Diocese of Charleston.
